# THE JOURNEY OF OUR FOUNDER

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**Mrs. Sarvath Adil Khan** began her journey into the area of social service almost a decade ago. She felt deeply for the downtrodden and the problems they faced.

Mrs. Khan realised that most of the difficulties faced by the people from the lower strata of society stemmed from lack of education. Due to illiteracy the disadvantaged folks didn't have proper means of employment and poverty made them ignore taking up education of any kind or sending their children to schools.

This was when Mrs. Khan took upon herself the challenging task of empowering the needy. She started visiting government schools and encouraged the students to study well. She began training them in English language too. Along with teaching the children she started focusing on their parents and began counselling them to change the way they led their lives. She influenced them to improve the quality of their living by creating general awareness among them. Mrs. Khan herself had taken a break from studies after II PUC as she got married. She resumed her studies after marriage and today has a post graduate degree in Psychology. While Mrs. Khan experienced a gap in studies she realised what kind of hurdles are faced by dropouts. This very reason motivated her to begin an academy which exclusively catered to dropouts. She founded Learning Point Foundation four years ago. The NGO specialises in imparting NIOS 10th and 12th standard education to dropouts. Apart from providing excellent training to students in different subjects Learning Point Foundation works on the overall development of students and helps them till they are gainfully employed. Mrs. Khan has been a great inspiration and role model to students and teachers as well. Being a certified Cambridge trainer, she has extended extensive training to many aspirants who seek Cambridge certificate. She is responsible for shaping the lives of hundreds of students and teachers giving them better lives. She has overcome many hindrances and successfully managed to train students at Learning Point Foundation with the much needed generosity of donors. Mrs. Khan says her journey so far has been very fulfilling and she looks forward to many more rewarding years of serving the society to the best of her capabilities.

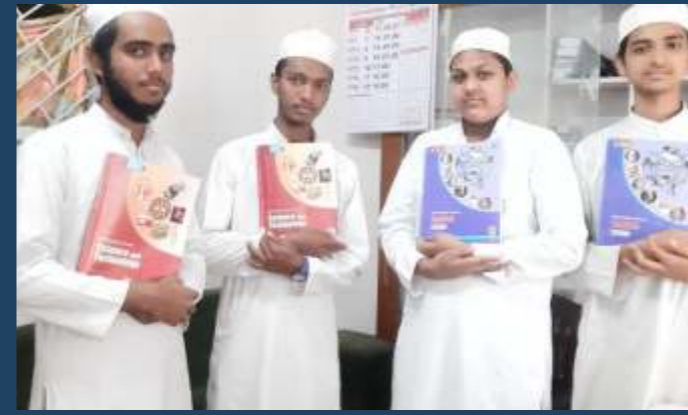
## BACK TO SCHOOL

Young boys and girls, orphans, single mothers, widows, huffaz and others who belong to marginalized classes are given best education at the centre. Our aim is to provide education for one and all irrespective of their socio-economic backgrounds. Dropouts receive a fresh start and motivation at Learning Point Foundation where dreams are converted into reality and nurtured for a bright future.







## AEMS - Academic Education for Madrasa Students

AEMS is an ambitious project and the brainchild of Mrs. Sarvath Adil Khan the Managing Trustee of Learning Point Foundation. AEMS aims to impart academic education to Huffaz and Aalims along with the syllabus they learn at the madrasas already. As a part of the AEMS course English language training, personality development classes and basic computing skills are being taught to students along with other subjects as per NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling) for their overall development keeping in mind the competitive world all of us live in today. We dream of creating professional huffaz and alims that's why training them in academics becomes all the more important and is certainly the need of the hour. With programmes like AEMS we hope madrasas will be havens of teaching academic as well as Islamic education to students in the coming days.

In this direction we started project AEMS last year in two madrasas Darul Sadaf (Mariyam Binte Imran) and Darul Uloom Rasheediya. This year we have started the project in madrasas Jamia Tayyibaat and Kulliyatul Banath Ummul Khair Fathima.



## TEACHERS' TRAINING

Learning Point Foundation offers excellent training opportunities for teachers to enhance their knowledge of teaching. The teaching skill of teachers is improved tremendously and they are made up-to-date in their field of expertise. The teachers' training programmes conducted by Learning Point Foundation helps teachers in broadening their career opportunities.

## JOB PLACEMENTS

Individuals with the education of 10th and 12th standard are offered job placements in various sectors. Interviews are conducted at Learning Point Foundation to find suitable jobs for the candidates. Training is provided to candidates to enhance their chances of employability. This is done through our employment centre, LP Jobs - Transforming Lives Through Employment.



## INTERVIEW SKILLS AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT

Interview skills and personality development programmes are conducted for interviewees who are not confident of facing interviews. In-depth training is provided to candidates in interview skills with examples and mock sessions in order to build their self-confidence levels and prepare them to face job interviews. Personality Development classes are conducted for students and aspiring interviewees in order to polish their already prevalent skills and talents. Learning Point Foundation focuses on the overall development of individuals to improve and enhance their personality to face the ever changing and fast paced competitive world.



## WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Learning Point Foundation has been working for the betterment of women from the time it began operations. Our NGO takes pride in empowering women who come from the disadvantaged sections of society. Learning Point Foundation gives utmost importance to the education of women who belong to the deprived classes. Whether it is widows or single mothers, orphan girls or uneducated women our NGO supports them to get a new lease of life through education and empowerment.

She joined Learning Point Foundation to complete NIOS 10th. She is a mother of two children. Marriage and having children didn't stop Shabreen from studying further. She has joined a diploma in Lab Technology and hopes to join a job in the future. She is an inspiration to married women and mothers who want to achieve a balance in their personal and academic lives. She scored 70% in 10th standard final exams in the year 2021-22.

She has studied NIOS 12th at Learning Point Foundation. Her husband is no more. She is working in a pharmacy for her livelihood along with that of her three children. Sameena rejoined studies after the death of her husband. She didn't want to give up on life and was determined to stay strong and achieve her goals. She has set an example for all widowed women with her grit and resilience. She scored 91% in 12th standard final exams in the year 2021-22.

is 57-year-old. He studied NIOS 12th at Learning Point Foundation. He had discontinued his studies due to some personal problems and started working to support his family. Being aged did not stop Ronald from studying further. He is currently working in service marketing. He has an ambition to have a MBA or diploma in Hotel Management. We as an organisation are keen to support government schools in the best way possible by providing them with any kind of assistance they require in imparting education to students.



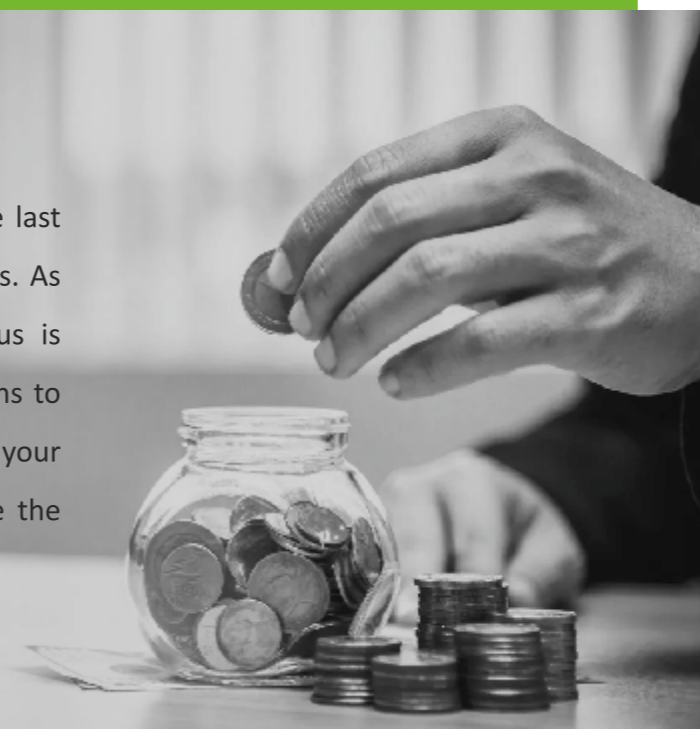
## EDUCATION OF POOR CHILDREN

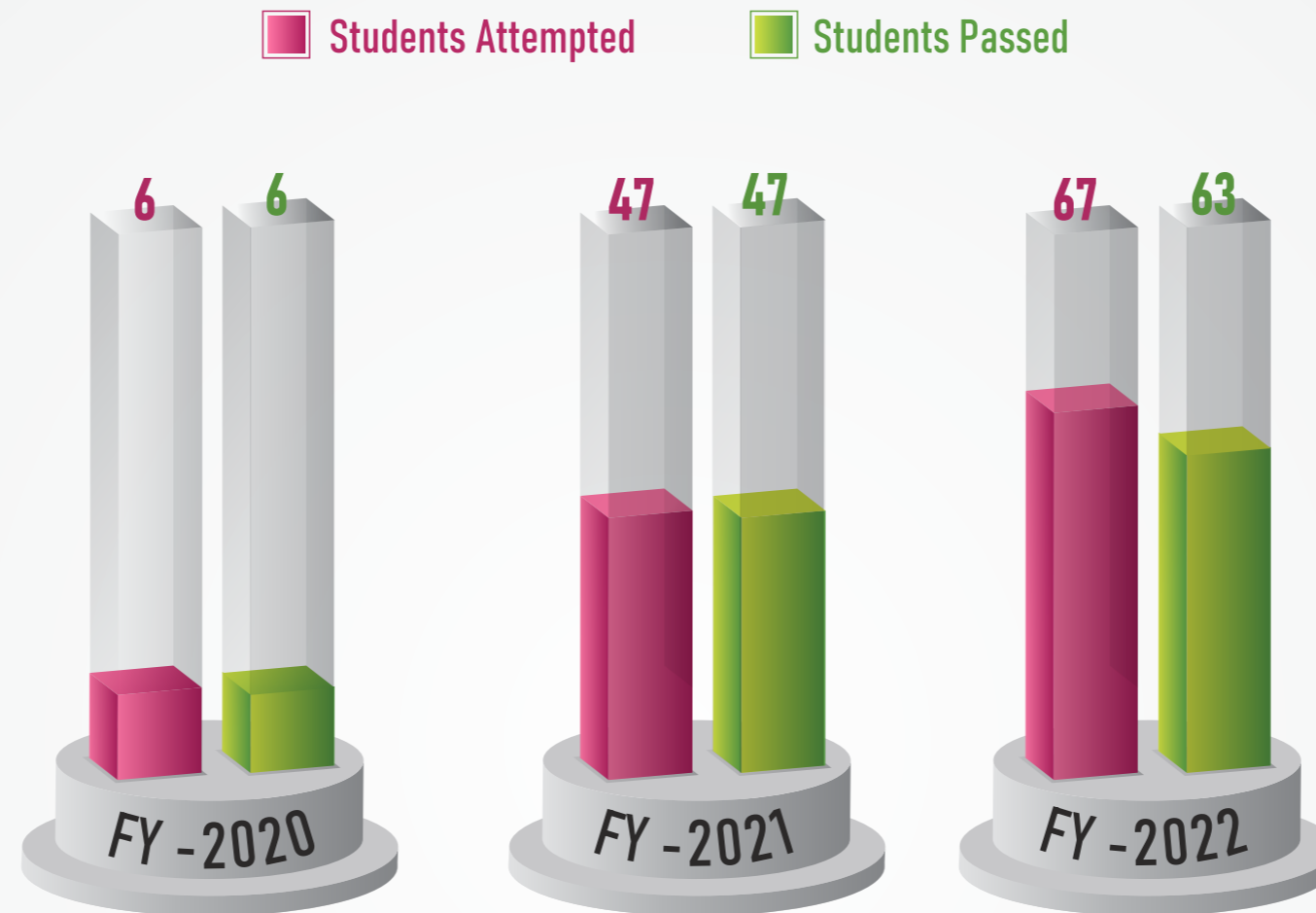

# 96.7% PASS RATE IN 10TH STD NIOS FROM 2019-22



In the last four years for 10th standard the pass percentage of boys and girls attending classes offline is 98% and 95% respectively. The madrasa boys have a pass percentage of 96% whereas the girls have cent percent results.

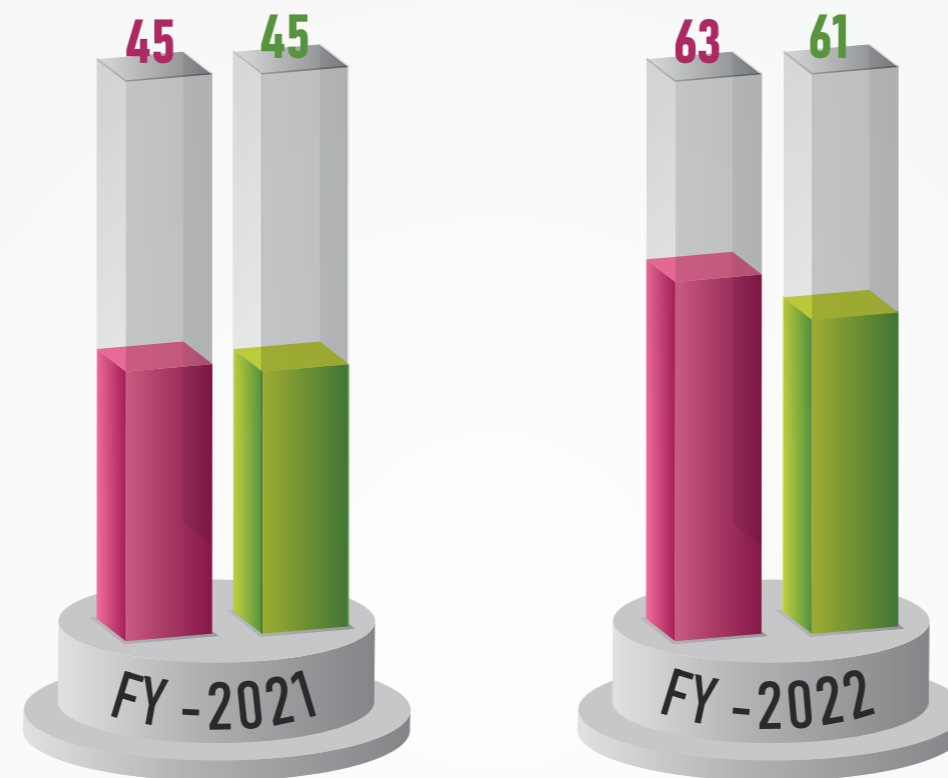
In 2019-20 there were a total of six students, four boys and two girls attending offline classes. All the students attempted the exams and obtained 100% results during the pandemic. In 2020-21 there were a total of 47 students out of whom 17 were madrasa boys and 3 were madrasa girls.

All the students attempted the exams and obtained 100% results during the pandemic. In 2021-22 there were a total of 67 students out of whom 8 were madrasa boys and 5 were madrasa girls.

All the students attempted the exams 97% boys and 92% girls attending classes at Learning Point Foundation and 88% madrasa boys and 100% madrasa girls cleared the exams.

■ Students Attempted      ■ Students Passed



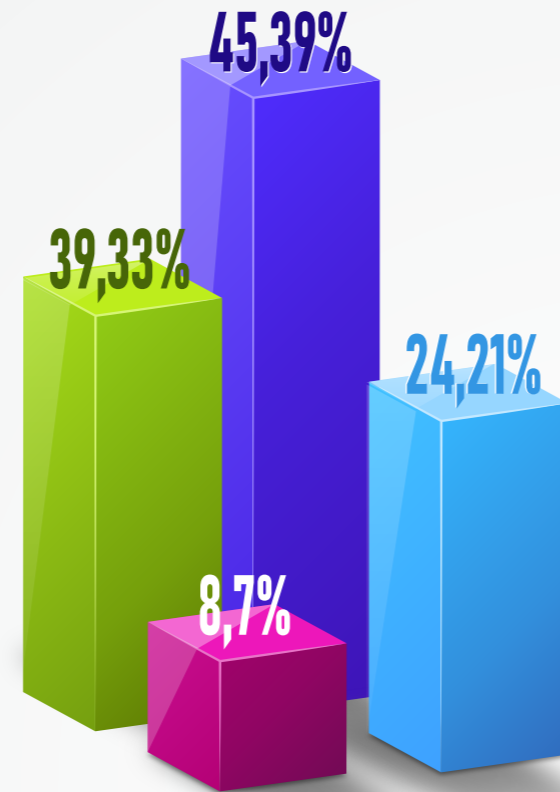
In the last four years for 12th standard the pass percentage of boys and girls attending classes offline is 98% and 100% respectively. The madrasa boys have a pass percentage of 90% whereas the girls have cent percent results.

In 2020-21 there were a total of 45 students out of whom 6 were madrasa boys and 3 were madrasa girls. All the students attended exams and obtained cent percent results during the pandemic.

In 2021-22 there were a total of 63 students out of whom 4 were madrasa boys and 6 were madrasa girls. All the students attempted the exams and 97% percent boys attending offline classes and 100% girls attending offline classes cleared the exams. 75% was the pass percentage of madrasa boys and 100% was the pass percentage of madrasa girls.

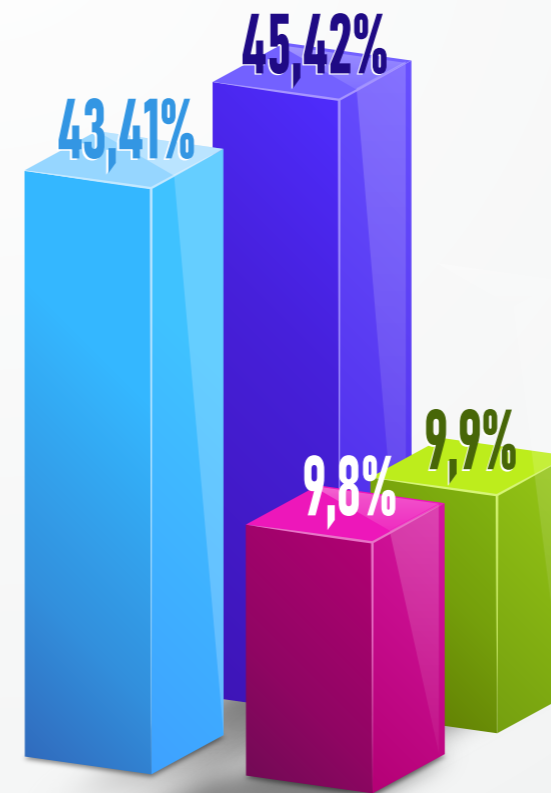

# SPOKEN ENGLISH

## 2 MONTH COURSE: 2018-22

■ Students Trained      ■ Students Placed



In 2018-19 a total of 14 students took up the spoken English course which includes **11 boys** and **3 girls**. 7 students got placed making the percentage of placed students as 50% which was done with the help of Learning Point Foundation.

In 2019-20 a total of 115 students took up spoken English course which includes **45 boys** and **70 girls** from Madrasa. The percentage of students getting placed during this year is 48% with 55 students getting successfully placed.

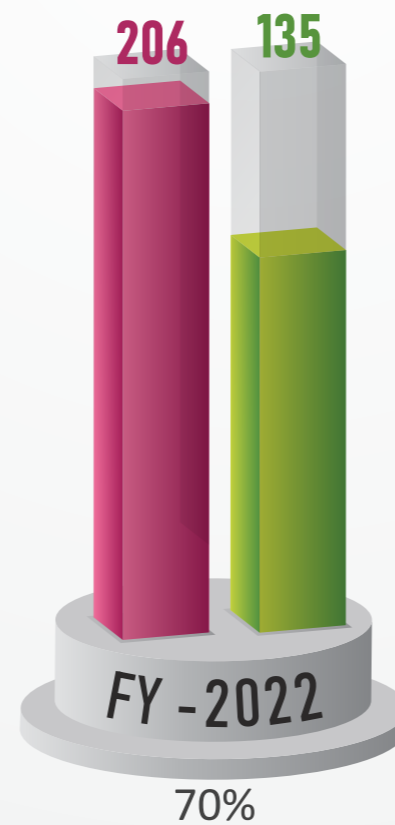
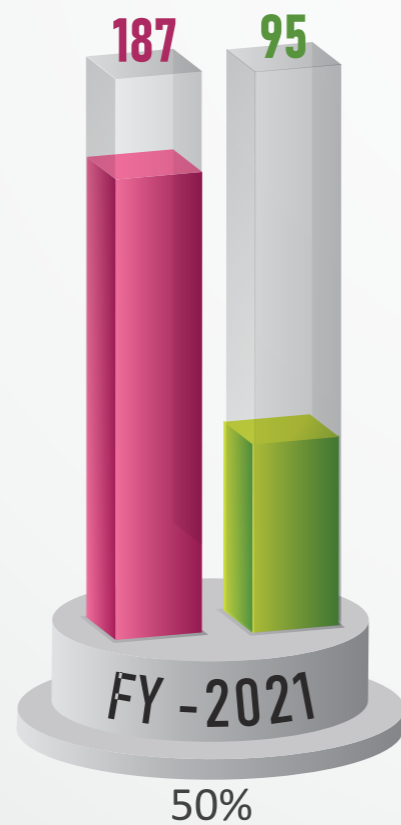
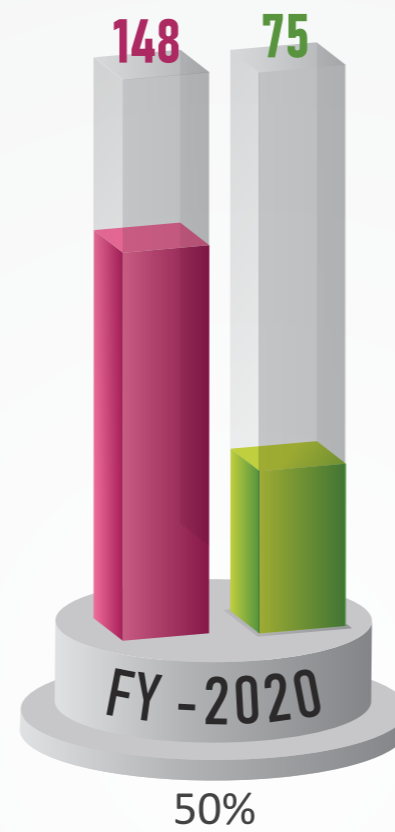
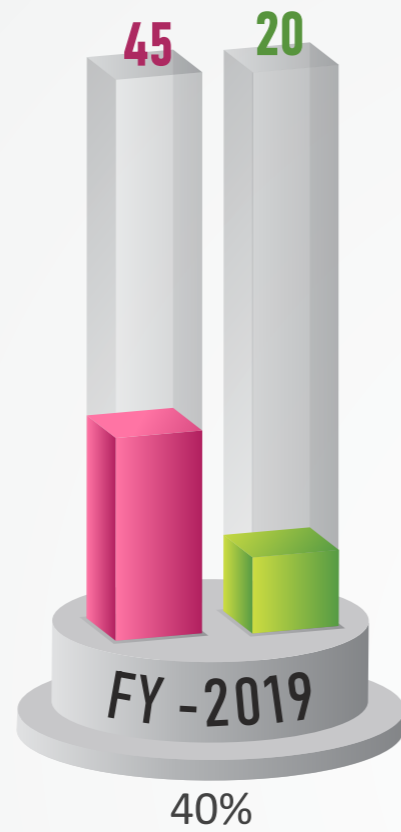
In 2020-21 a total of 122 students took up the spoken English course which includes **50 boys** and **72 girls** out of whom 68 students got placed with the percentage of placements being 60%.

In 2021-22 a total of 80 students took up the spoken English course which comprises of **30 boys** and **50 Madrasa girls** with the percentage of students that were placed being 70% indicating that 53 students obtained placements successfully.

In **2018-19** a total of 45 students got trained for jobs. This included **30 boys** and **15 girls**. 40% of the students got into placements with 20 students getting employed.

In **2019-20** a total of 148 students got trained for jobs. This included **100 boys** and **48 girls**. 50% of the students got placed with 75 students getting employed.

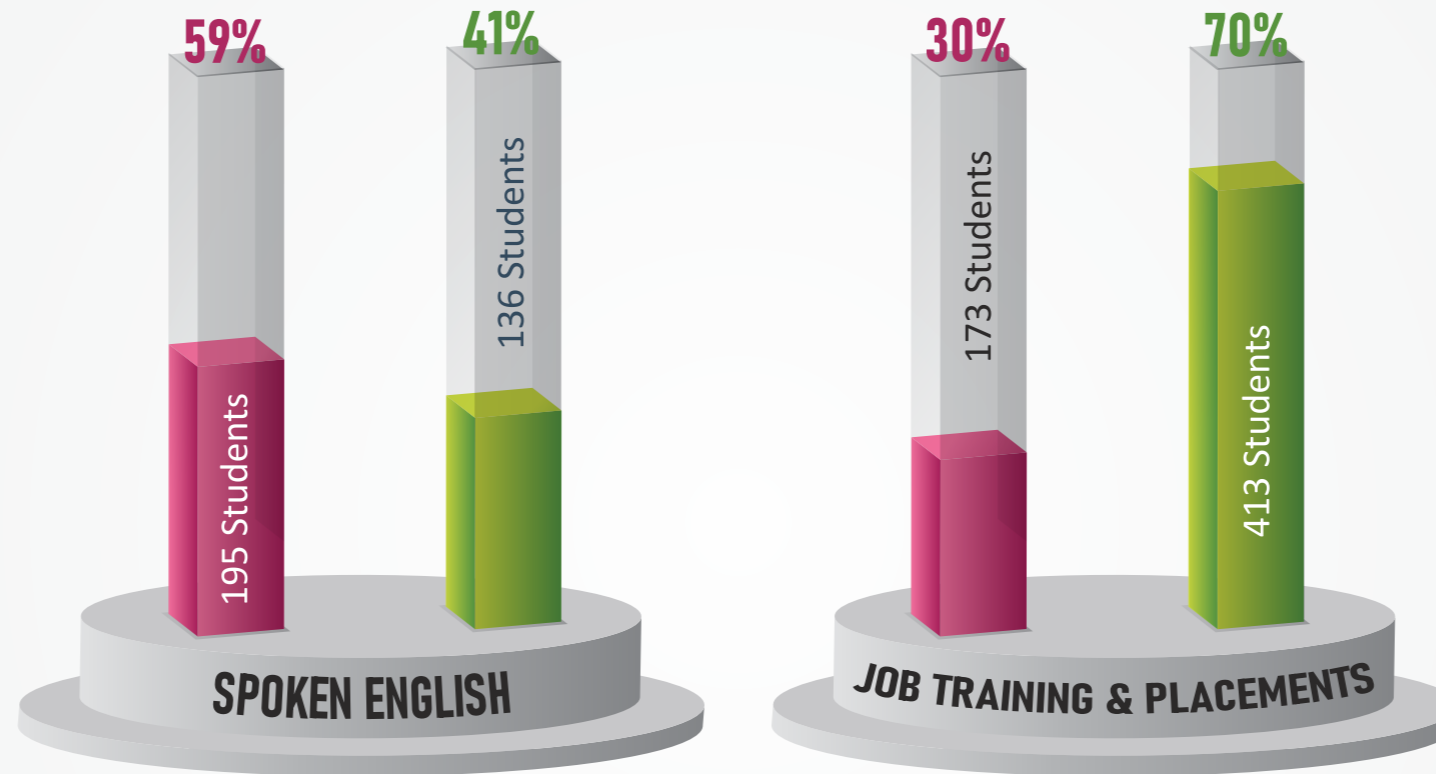
In **2020-21** a total of 187 students got trained for jobs. This included **147 boys** and **40 girls**. 50% of the students got placed with 95 students getting into jobs.

In **2021-22** a total of 206 students got trained to obtain placements. This included **136 boys** and **70 girls**. 70% of the students got placed with 135 students getting employed.

FROM 2018 TO 2022 - 60% BOYS & 40% GIRLS

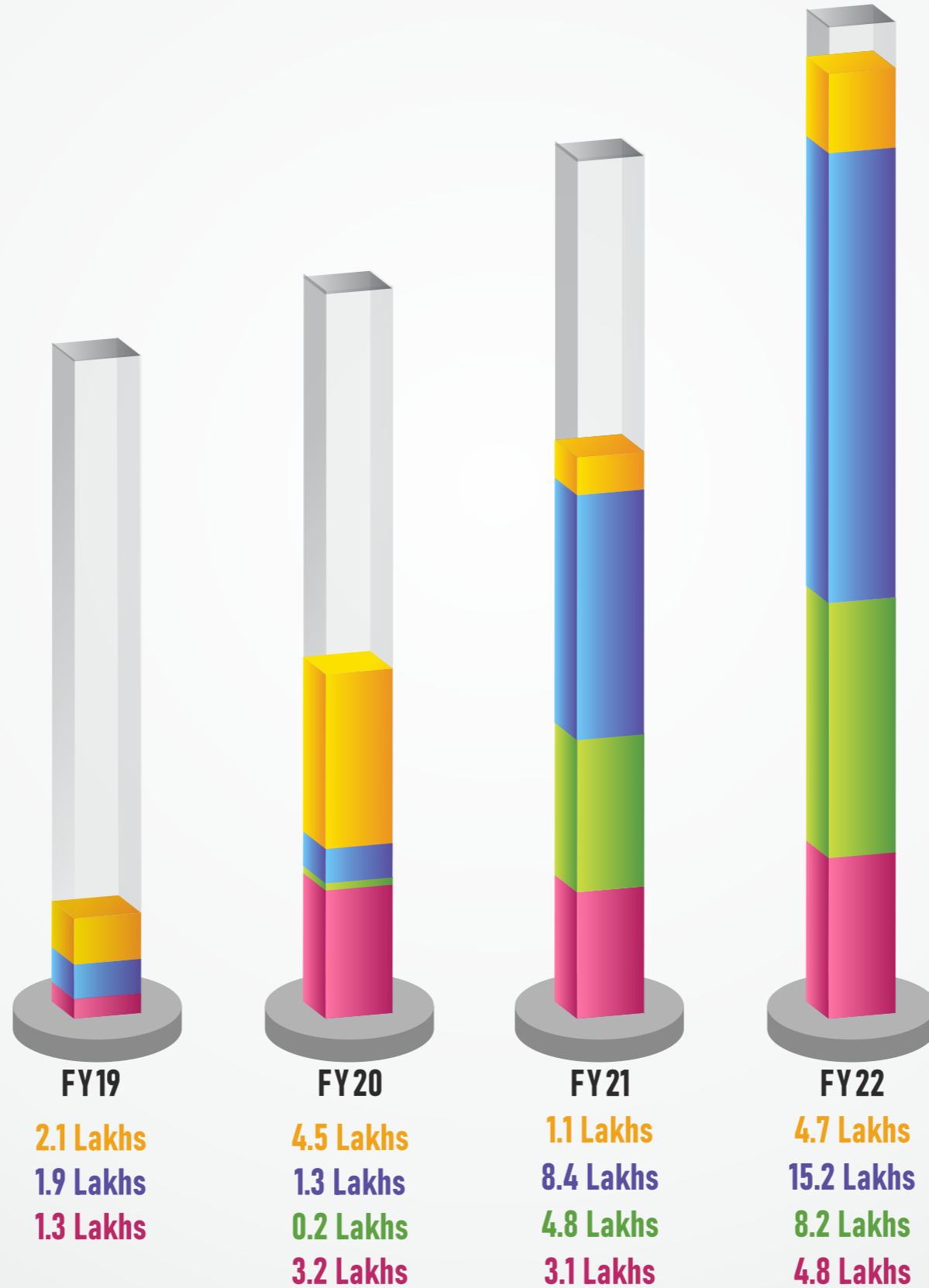

# EXPENDITURE BY CATEGORY: 2018-22

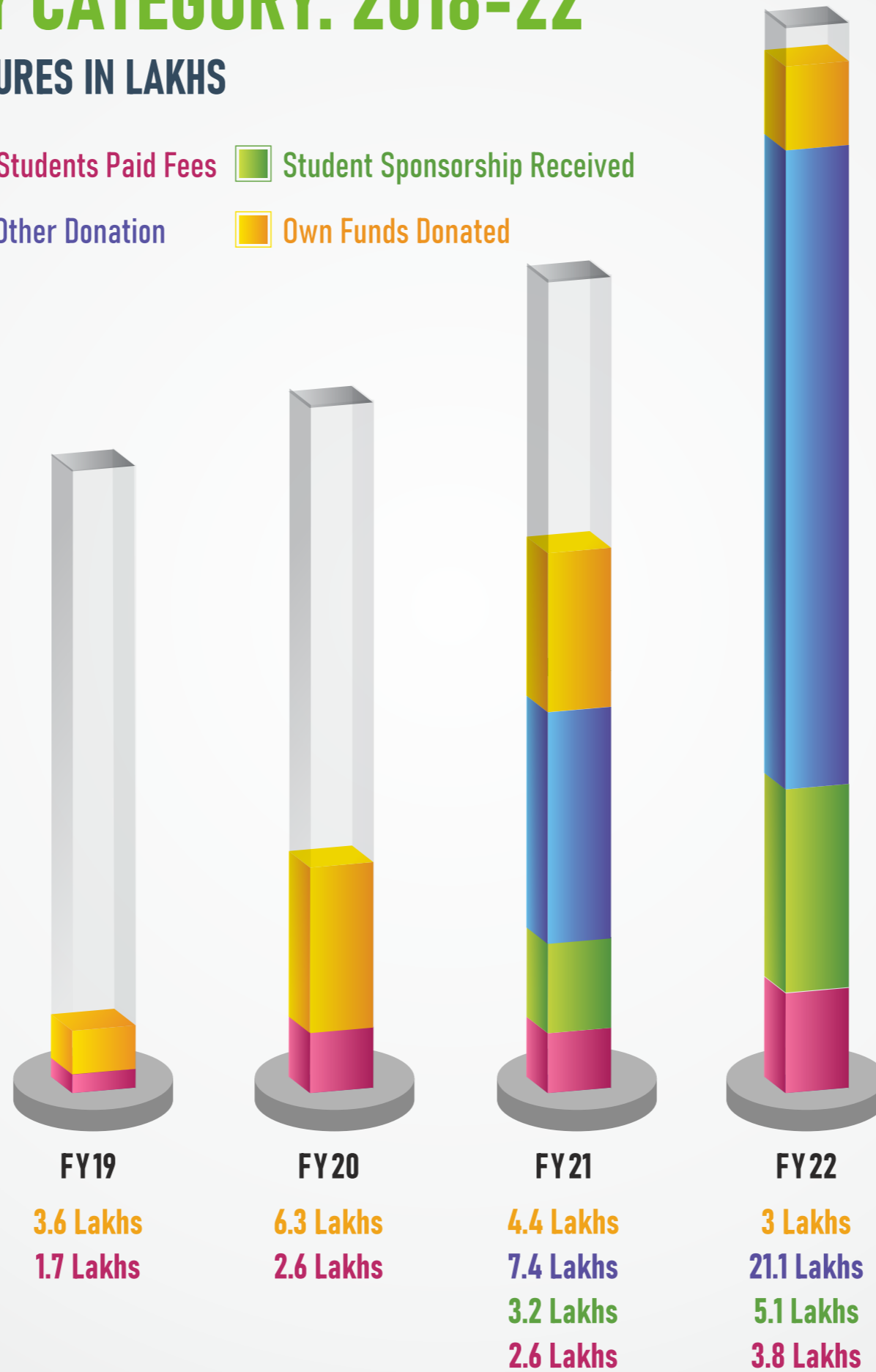

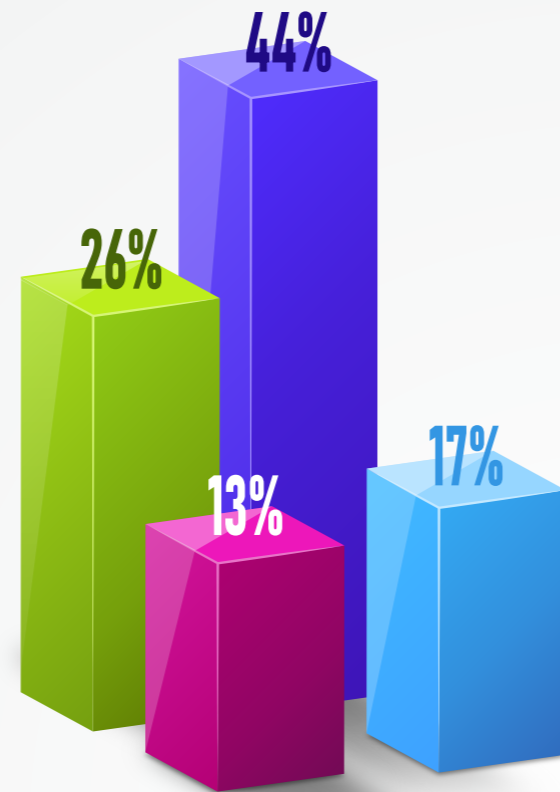
# RECEIPTS BY CATEGORY: 2018-22

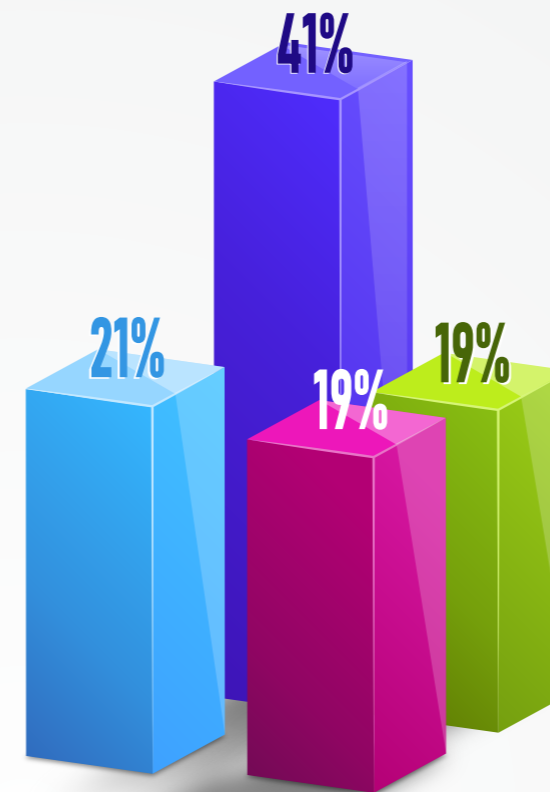
